	GRE® General Test	GMAT™ Exam
Content	Three measures: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning and Analytical Writing. <u>Learn more</u> .	Four measures: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, Analytical Writing and Integrated Reasoning (source).
Fees	\$220 in most locations, regardless of whether you test at a center or at home. <u>See all fees</u> .	Pricing varies by country but generally ranges from \$250-\$275 to test at a center and \$275-\$300 to test at home. See all fees.
Score reports	Four score reports are included with your fee. Additional score reports are \$30. <u>Learn more</u> .	Five score reports are included with your fee (source). Additional score reports are \$35 (source).
Test experience	In each section, you have flexibility to move around, answer questions in the order of your choosing and change answers. <u>Learn more</u> .	Questions must be answered in the order in which they are received and you cannot change your answers (source).
Calculator	A calculator is provided during the Quantitative Reasoning sections. <u>Learn more</u> .	A calculator is not allowed during the Quantitative Reasoning section but is provided for use during the Integrated Reasoning section (source).
Test format	The Verbal and Quantitative Reasoning measures are section-level adaptive, meaning the second section of Quant you receive will be easier or harder based on your performance on the first section of Quant. Same for Verbal. This test format allows you to move freely within each section and change your answers if you'd like. Your score doesn't decrease if you answer incorrectly so it's always in your best interest to guess. Learn more.	The GMAT is question-level adaptive, meaning the program selects your next question based on your previous responses. This test format prevents you from being able to move freely within each section or change your answers. Your scores will reflect the number of questions answered and decrease significantly with each unanswered question (source).

Official scores	Typically available within 8 calendar days, but may take up to 15 calendar days to process. <u>Learn more</u> .	Typically available within 7 business days, but may take up to 20 business days to process (<u>source</u>).
